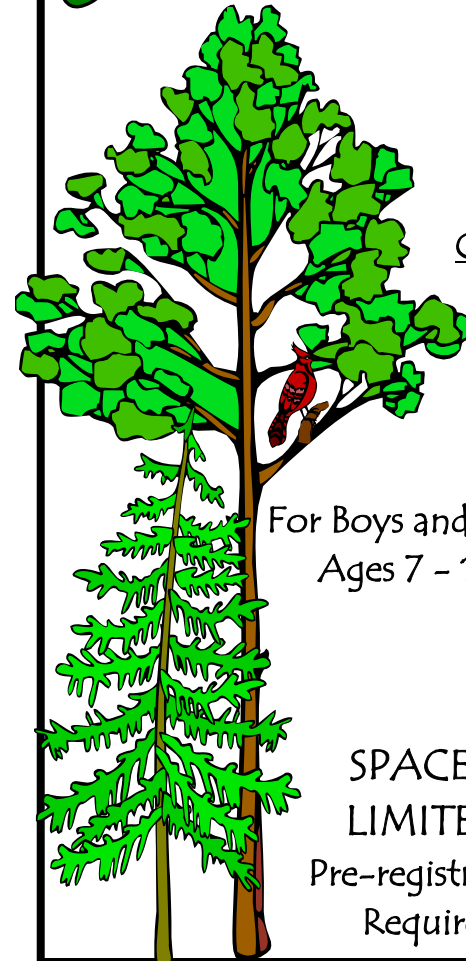

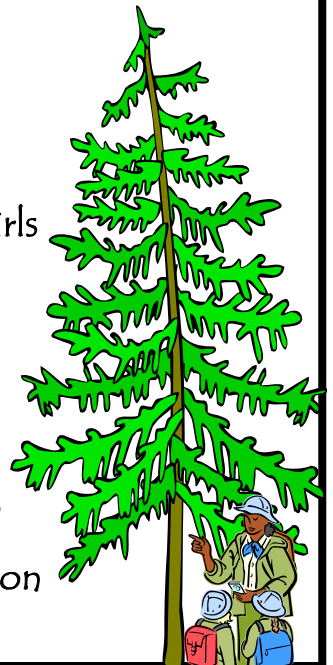

Programs at both Minden & Haliburton Sessions

MONDAY: <i>Something's Fishy</i>	Why are some fish long and others short? Why do some have stripes and others spots? These are some of the questions we will explore through games and other fun activities. Come and find out what is so wonderfully fishy about Haliburton!
TUESDAY: <i>A Whole Lota Ungulata!</i>	Ungu whata? It's a cow, it's a moose, it's a goat, it's a deer ... but what makes them different? Through investigation and games you will have fun learning about the hoofed creatures of our forests.
WEDNESDAY: <i>When It Rains, It Pours!</i>	The clouds bring us rain but where does the rain go? ... Into our Watersheds! With hands on activities you will see the effect rain has on our lakes and rivers and the importance of wetlands along these systems. Come prepared to get your hands wet and have a lot of fun doing it!
THURSDAY: <i>Happening Herps</i>	They slither, hop and walk; some are slimy and some are not. Do you know who they are? Join us as we investigate the differences between reptiles and amphibians. We will also discover some problems these misunderstood creatures are facing and what we can do to help.
FRIDAY: <i>Nature's Patterns</i>	During this exploratory hike, we will be looking closely at nature's artistry. Discovering masterpieces such as spider webs, beetle engravings, leaf vein designs and butterfly wings we will share, discuss and appreciate.
