Education and a good control program go together in the fight against mosquitoes.

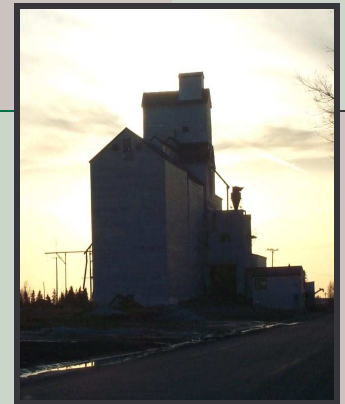

Mosquito Management 1

Services available for a complete program

- ▶ Assistance with Saskatchewan government grant application forms.
- ▶ Locating and determining size of standing water sites.
- ▶ Pre-sampling of sites to assess infestation.
- ▶ Mapping of water sites using Global Positioning System to obtain coordinates of each site to an accuracy of .5 meters.
- ▶ Data compiling and reporting of problem areas.
- ▶ Digital overlay of map points to assist community in finding water site locations.
- ▶ Applications made to SERM – Saskatchewan Environment Resource Management for mandatory permits.
- ▶ Record keeping and year-end reporting required by SERM.
- ▶ Treatment of infested water sites.
- ▶ Pre-treatment and post treatment data collection.
- ▶ Adulticiding with foggers to enhance the enjoyment of local community functions.
- ▶ Applicators available to apply barrier treatments to protect areas like yard sites, playgrounds etc.
