Cherokee/Kennebec - Mid –season, white potato with gnarly exterior. Excellent flavour.

Desiree - Mid-season with red skin and yellow flesh producing high yields that cook and store well.

Estima - Mid-season, yellow fleshed, brown skinned potato good for cooking.

Fianna - Early, yellow fleshed tuber similar to Yukon Gold.

French Fingerling/Banana - Late maturing, oblong tubers with red skin, light yellow flesh and waxy texture. It grows and sets fairly heavy.

German Butterball/Sieglinde - Late, yellow flesh, great for eating fresh or storing throughout the winter.

Gold Rush – Mid-season, good size and yields, russet skin with white flesh, great for baking and storage.

Hertha - Late, yellow flesh with lots of tubers. (Plant later to get smaller tubers.)

Norland - Early, red-skinned potato, white flesh. Has some resistance to scab and black scurf. Stores well.

Onaway - early, white variety with round tubers.

Red Chieftain - Mid to late season, red skin, white flesh. Good all around use potato. Stores well. Has good disease resistance.

Russian Blue-Late maturing, dark blue skin and flesh with round to oblong tubers. A heavy setting large plant should be spaced 12” or more apart to get them to full maturity. Nice flavour boiled.

Russet Burbank (Netted Gem)- Late season, heirloom with white flesh and heavy netted russet skin. Good storage, and good all purpose potato.

Yukon Gold – Early maturing, yellow skin and flesh, shallow pink eyes. Great taste and good storage. Not a heavy producer. Recommended to plant Single Drop only.
